3. You are to use a piece of poster board for your project.
4. You may use any or all of the following visual materials:
 - maps
 - drawings
 - photographs
 - newspapers
 - magazines
 - postcards
5. Each theme must be clearly labeled.
6. You will be required to orally explain your poster to the class using your descriptions for each of the five themes.
7. The following are some suggestions to help you with each theme:
 - LOCATION Exact - latitude & longitude, state, city, street address
 - Relative - How far do you live from school in blocks, miles, or minutes?
 - PLACE Illustrate your bedroom, home or neighborhood.
 - HUMAN/ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION
 - How do you interact with your environment (fishing, skiing, camping, gardening)?
 - How has your environment been changed by people (parks, roads, pollution)?
 - MOVEMENT Trace your daily movements from home to school. Where have you lived or travelled? Show your family car, your bicycle, an airplane, or school bus.
 - REGION Illustrate regions you have lived in, for example your neighborhood, city, state, country, plains, or mountains.
 Illustrate the climate or plant life or the region in which you live.
