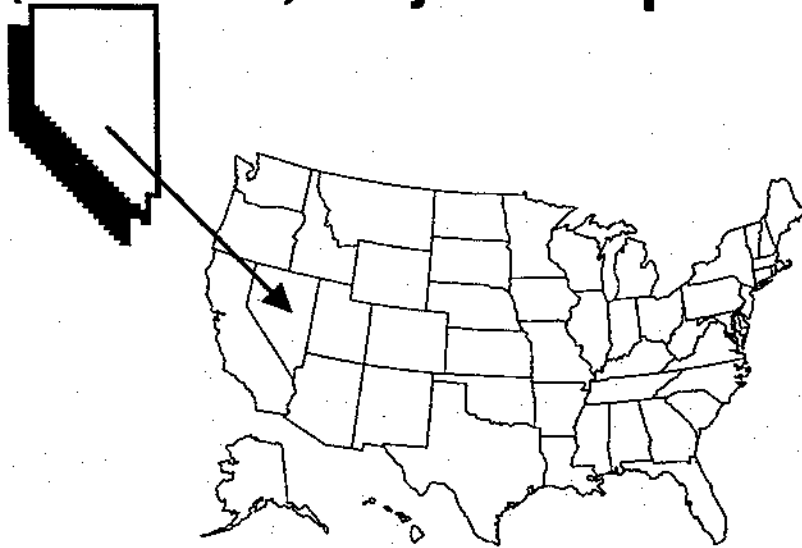

**How people react to and change the environment.**

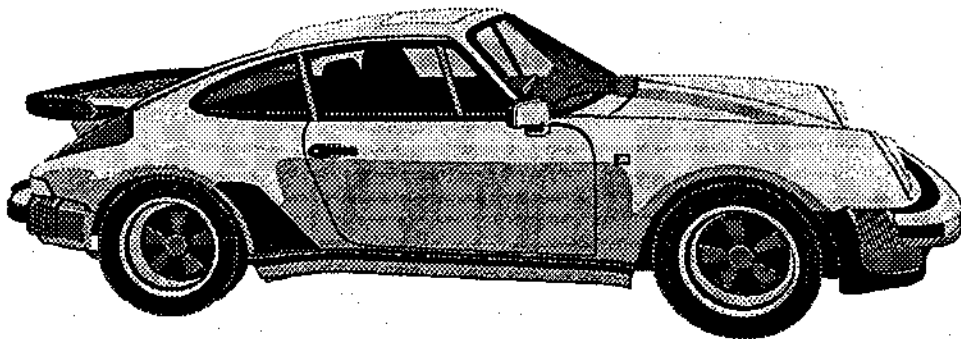
